Atkinson Gallery at Santa Barbara City College presents Office of Loss Control, a daring exhibit which features two of the Art Department's new faculty members Armando Ramos and Stephanie Washburn. The exhibit will open with a reception on Friday, January 27 from 5 – 7 p.m. in The Atkinson Gallery (721 Cliff Dr.).

Ramos and Washburn may work with different media, but they both venture into contemporary life topics through the avenues of dark humor and pop culture.

Ramos is an artist that takes images from everyday life and redirects their connotations and meaning by employing irony. Ramos's art challenges the ideas of popular culture. Ramos completed his undergraduate degree at the Kansas City Art Institute and completed his graduate degree Montana State University. Since then, he has been an artist in residence in The Richard Cartier Studios in Napa, CA, Vermont Studio Center in Johnson, VT and at California State University at Long Beach in Long Beach, CA. He has had his work featured in the Virginia Brier Gallery, The Oakland Museum, The Dairy Art Center, Elmhurst Art Museum, Studio Couture, and the North Dakota Museum of Art. Most recently, he was awarded the Individual Artist Grant from the North Dakota Council on the Arts.
