

Another exhibition to look forward to at Atkinson Gallery is Rafa Esparza's "for you and the sky." Rafa Esparza's recent installations center largely on hand-making adobe bricks, produced in collaboration with his father in Los Angeles.

The brick-making technique employed by Esparza is used throughout Mexico, and it is the same approach his father used to build his first house in Mexico before immigrating to the United States. The artist first used bricks in the performance, "Casa Adobe," at SOMArts in San Francisco in 2011.

Esparza's work with adobe has also been showcased at the Hammer Museum's "Made in L.A." exhibition, as well as Hollywood's LACE gallery, where he created a building inside of a building using 5,000 adobe bricks. Esparza's work examines the different forms of evolution in local and indigenous cultural productions, in relation to narratives of Western art such as histories of sculptural installation.


